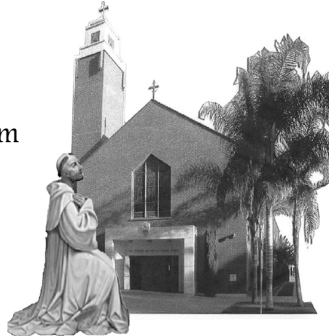

Dear parishioners:

The King came to us, humble, sitting on a donkey ; he came with haste to suffer his Passion and take sins away. Seated on a dumb animal, the Word, the Wisdom of God, wants to save all beings endowed with reason. And all humankind can contemplate, mounted on a colt, the one who rides on the cherubim and who once bore up Elijah on a chariot of fire. "Though he was rich," of his own will, "he became poor; in choosing weakness he gives strength to all who cry to him: "Blessed are you, the one who comes in the name of the Lord". He demonstrates strength by choosing poverty. The clothes of the disciples were a sign of their poverty. He saves those who are humbled and have mercy.

He was crucified for us, and we were rescued from death. Jesus, anointed by God with the power of the Holy Spirit, who lived all his life doing good and healing all the oppressed was killed by fanatical Jews. They killed him by hanging him on a tree. But God has risen Him and granted the grace to manifest those who had ate and drank with him. Dear parishioners: keep receiving Him, stay close to Him so, after the resurrection of the dead, you will see Him alive.

ESTIMADA TÍA TOTA

"Aunque era rico", por su propia voluntad, "se hizo pobre; al elegir la debilidad, para dar fuerza a todos los que le claman: "Bendito el que viene en el nombre del Señor". Demostró su fortaleza eligiendo la debilidad. Él salva a aquellos que son humildes. Él tiene misericordia de los que lo reconocen como su Señor y Salvador. DID YOU KNOW:**Ongoing child sexual abuse prevention training**

Since 2002, the Archdiocese of Los Angeles has trained about 330,000 adults to proactively protect children and young people from child sexual abuse and reporting misconduct. In addition, over 165,000 children and young people receive safe environment training annually. In 2018, the Office of Safeguard the Children launched its new "Empowering God's Children & Young People" Program, which empowers children and young people by giving them the knowledge and tools to keep themselves safe and teaches them to tell a parent, guardian or safe adult if anyone makes them feel uncomfortable, scared or confuse.

Desde el 2002, la Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles ha capacitado cerca de 330,000 adultos para proteger proactivamente a los niños y jóvenes del abuso sexual infantil y para denunciar toda conducta indebida. Además, más de 165,000 niños y jóvenes reciben capacitación sobre un ambiente seguro cada año. En el 2018, la Oficina Protegiendo a los Niños lanzó su nuevo programa "Dar poder a los niños y jóvenes de Dios", el cual otorga poder a los niños y jóvenes por medio de los conocimientos y las herramientas para que se mantengan seguros, y les enseña cómo conversar sobre el tema con sus padres, cuidador o adulto confiable si alguien los hace sentir incómodos, asustados o confundidos.

WHAT IS DIVINE MERCY?



Jesus, I Trust In You

It is God's love for us! God loves all of us. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others.

FORMS OF DEVOTION

VENERATION OF THE IMAGE - Our Lord appeared to St. Faustina in a vision and instructed her to paint an image according to the pattern she saw with the signature: *Jesus, I trust in You.* Jesus told St. Faustina, *"I promise that the soul who will venerate this Image will not perish."* (D 47)

PRAYING THE CHAPLET - Jesus told St. Faustina, *"Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you. When they say this Chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between my Father and the dying person not as the Just Judge but as the Merciful Savior."* (D1541)

FEAST OF DIVINE MERCY - Divine Mercy Sunday points us to the merciful love of God that lies behind the Paschal mystery of the passion, death and resurrection of Christ made present in the Eucharist. Jesus promised to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy to those who will go to confession and receive Holy Communion. (D699) It is celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter.

NOVENA - On Good Friday in 1937, Jesus requested that St. Faustina make a special novena before the Feast of Mercy from Good Friday through the following Saturday. He Himself dictated the intention for each day. By means of a specific prayer, she was to bring to His Heart a different group of souls each day and thus immerse them in the ocean of His Mercy.

ST. FAUSTINA - St. Faustina was an uneducated nun of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. She received from the Lord a message of mercy to be spread throughout the world. She was asked to become the Apostle and Secretary of God's mercy.



HOUR OF GREAT MERCY - Our Lord asked for a special prayer and meditation on His passion each afternoon at the 3 o'clock hour, the hour that recalls His death on the cross. He said, *"In this hour I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My passion."* (D1320)
