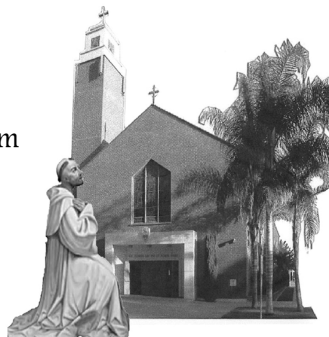

Dear parishioners:

Today is the Good Shepherd Sunday and the short text of John defines what it means to be "Pastor". Jesus is the true Shepherd because he is in constant relationship with the Father; he knows the sheep intimately and gives his life for them; he knows them and they follow him; it gives them eternal life; they will not perish and no one will snatch them out of his hand.

It also defines those true followers of Jesus: they are those who listen to his voice; they are united in receiving his Word and his person, they care for and give privilege to a personal relationship with Jesus, they seek to know Jesus Christ and come to receive his food in the Eucharist, in prayer, in the interiorization of the Gospel message, they recognize themselves as called to follow Jesus and they feel sent to spread the good news.

The authority of Jesus is not authoritarianism, but is love and service selflessly, going ahead doing what he says... He does not assert himself in power, he gives himself in food, he does not distance himself to protect his authority, he approaches and gives his life for his "sheep".

Let us not forget that the pastors are not only the Pope, the bishops, the priests, in some way all the agents of evangelization in the Church are pastors: parents, catechists, those of the liturgy, those who prepare for the sacraments, etc. We are all the image of the Church for those who come and - as the first reading reminds us - also for those who do not come. Like Jesus, our power must be a power made service even if it creates conflicts with the powers of this world. We need good shepherds, who tend to the weak, helpless and needy sheep with predilection; to make their needs, complaints and hopes theirs; who attract to the misguided ones.

A LETTER FOR MY GRANDMA: I write to you very happy and full of vitality after receiving the visit of 3 of my 12 siblings. They came from Mexico with their young children to celebrate my birthday. I had a great party last Sunday thanks to them, along with some St. Bernard and St Paschal de Baylon parishioners. My emotional state improved a lot after seeing the people I love the most altogether. God bless all my parishioners: they always take me out of trouble and make my priesthood more bearable. Queridos hermanos:

Hoy es el domingo del Buen Pastor y el breve texto de Juan nos define lo que significa ser "Pastor". Jesús es el verdadero Pastor porque está en constante relación con el Padre; conoce a las ovejas íntimamente y da la vida por ellas; las conoce y ellas le siguen; les da la vida eterna; no perecerán para siempre y nadie las arrebatara de su mano.

Nos define también cómo son los verdaderos seguidores de Jesús: son aquellos que escuchan su voz; que están unidos recibiendo su Palabra y su persona, que cuidan y dan privilegio a una relación personal con Jesús, que buscan conocer a Jesucristo, que se acercan a recibir su alimento en la Eucaristía, en la oración, en la interiorización del mensaje evangélico, que se reconocen llamados a su seguimiento y que se sienten enviados.

La autoridad de Jesús no es autoritarismo, sino que es amor y sirve desinteresadamente, va por delante haciendo lo que dice a los suyos y entregándose. No se afirma en el poder, se da en alimento, no se distancia para proteger su autoridad, se acerca y da la vida por sus "ovejas".

No olvidemos que los pastores no somos sólo el Papa, los obispos, los sacerdotes, de alguna manera todos los agentes de evangelización en la Iglesia, son pastores: los padres de familia, los catequistas, los de la liturgia, los que preparan para los sacramentos, etc. Todos somos la imagen de la Iglesia para los que se acercan y - como nos recuerda la primera lectura- también para los que no vienen. Como Jesús, nuestro poder ha de ser un poder hecho servicio aunque cree conflictos con los poderes de este mundo. Necesitamos buenos pastores, que atiendan con predilección/a las ovejas débiles, desvalidas y necesitadas; que hagan suyas sus necesidades, sus quejas y sus esperanzas; que pacifiquen a las enfrentadas y atraigan a las descarriadas.
