VIRTUS

Relational bullying is unwarranted, persistent, unwelcome behavior in the form of criticism, isolation, or false allegations and rumors that damage the targeted person’s relationships. Relational bullying includes social exclusion, gossip, and withholding friendship, and it can be devastating for children and teens. These behaviors are more subtle than traditional bullying, often happening out of sight or earshot of adults. But this bullying requires intervention and action. Talk to your children about these behaviors, especially if you notice them being left out of social activities and friendships. Estos comportamientos son más sutiles que la intimidación tradicional, y a menudo ocurren fuera de la vista o del oído de los adultos. Pero esta intimidación requiere intervención y acción. Hable con sus hijos sobre estos comportamientos, especialmente si usted nota que ellos son excluidos de las actividades sociales y se aislados de las amistades. Dear Parishioner's,

Today's readings are about divine compassion. God revealed in the Bible, is a very tender and compassionate God. Our Heavenly Father "sympathizes" with a person because he loves us, "suffers with" the human being, broken, evicted, humiliated, hopeless and needy.

The reading of Isaiah (Is. 55,1-3), is part of the so-called "Book of consolation", in this poem the prophet tries to raise the spirits of the exiles with the hope of the imminent return to his land. Compassion is shown in a simple image: someone offering his wares for free: wheat, water, wine and milk, to hungry and thirsty men. Those products are offered to all, and they are free; the only requirement is to have a need to eat and drink.

Paul in the letter to the Romans (Rom. 8,35.37-39) invites us to unwavering trust in the love of God, which is the foundation of our security. God compassionately sustains and strengthens us against the vicissitudes of life.

Compassion is presented in the Gospel (Mt. 14,13-21) as a sign that the Kingdom of God is already among us. Compassion is a fundamental part of the Kingdom of God where each one of us gives freely to others the best that we have. Thus the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves is a "sign" of the life that Jesus has come to bring to the world. Abundant life. Number twelve surely relates to the disciples who are not the owners of the bread, but the ones responsible for distributing it to all freely and compassionately.

In this time when the pandemic is exhausting our spirits and hopes, the Word of God comes to encourage our trust in God. For the pandemic does not come from Him, but He himself suffers it together with us. Let us never forget his compassion, mercy and generosity with those most in need. The doors of his house are not open now, but those of his heart are always open. Let us draw closer to God to recharge ourselves with his sensitivity, tenderness and compassion. Let's keep praying for the end of the coronavirus.
