For your safety and the safety of your loved ones it is extremely important that you continue to practice social distancing and hand/area disinfecting.

Many languages are spoken in our world. Many times we don't understand each other. Surely in our city we also meet people who speak other languages on the street. Surely, in this country, we have gone through the experience of finding someone who did not understand our language when needed help.

Today we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit on that first group of apostles and disciples who, after the death and resurrection of Jesus, continued to meet to pray and remember the Master teachings. The coming of the Holy Spirit (Pentecost) had a wonderful effect. Suddenly, those who had been confined and frightened dared to go out into the streets and speak of Jesus to people from different places and backgrounds. The amazing thing was that everyone listened to the apostles speak in their own language about the wonders of God and about the great miracle that God had done in Jesus raising him from the dead. Since then, the Gospel has jumped across the borders of all nations. It has reached the most hidden corners of our world. And, with the Gospel, peace also came to many hearts as well as the ability to forgive like Jesus. Since Pentecost, the Church goes out into the world.
