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Parish School Principal
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Dear Parishioner's,

Neither the Pharisees nor the Herodians had been able to overcome Roman rule over Israel. In the time of Jesus, they did not openly confront the Emperor of Rome, nor did they rebel against the system of political, social and religious control. They had learned to tolerate such control in order to guarantee worship. They reduced all dimensions of religion to worship. Jesus came to show them that true religion leads the leaders of the People to a serious commitment to reality, and to work hard in the transformation of structures so that they guarantee the common good, justice and peace.

The Pharisees hide themselves behind a narcissistic legalism. The Herodians take advantage of his political influence. For both of them, the person of Jesus of Nazareth is a problem, since his words and gestures show that their hearts are far from God, far from the Law and far from the people they should guide, accompany and care for. Jesus, by revealing the Father and announcing the Kingdom, reveals the mediocrity and incoherence of the Pharisees and Herodians.

In the Gospel, the Herodians flatter Jesus because they lack credibility. Jesus does not allow himself to be entangled by such empty praise and clearly declares his Truth: "**we must give to God what belongs to Him.**" Jesus knows that the Pharisees are looking for an excuse to be able to accuse him and is not afraid to give a clear and committed answer because he speaks from his experience of God and from his faith: Jesus does not conform to the established order, especially when inequality, injustice or inequity is accentuated.

In the image of Jesus Christ, the baptized are called to create bonds of brotherhood that break the schemes of "them and us." The co-responsibility of Christians in the search for the common good and in caring for the common home (earth) calls us to respect plurality.

Saints Isaac Jogues and John de Brebeuf and their Companions—October 19

Their mission was to New France, but these missionaries found in present-day New York State and the province of Ontario a world wildly different from the homes they left behind. Six Jesuit priests, Fathers Isaac Jogues, John de Brébeuf, Anthony Daniel, Gabriel Lalemant, Charles Garnier, and Noël Chabanel—and Jesuit lay volunteers René Goupil and John LaLande—shared the gospel with the Native Americans they met, in languages they painstakingly learned, and through images they creatively adapted to the indigenous cultures (for example, John de Brébeuf's "Twas in the Moon of Wintertime: the Huron Carol"). But their evangelization was caught up in turmoil beyond their control: a smallpox epidemic, battles between French and English trading interests—the traders united only by their willingness to exploit the Native Americans—and conflict among the tribes themselves, Huron, Mohawk, Iroquois. The missionaries' perseverance despite exhausting hardships, their steadfast courage in facing unspeakable tortures, and undaunted love even for those who martyred them, bore fruit, immediately in Kateri Tekakwitha's sanctity, eventually in the Catholicism that still flourishes in the United States and Canada.

Estimados Feligreses,

Ni los fariseos ni los herodianos habían podido vencer la dominación romana sobre Israel. En el tiempo de Jesús, no enfrentaron abiertamente al Emperador de Roma, ni se rebelaron contra el sistema de control político, social y religioso. Habían aprendido a tolerar dicho control con tal de garantizar el culto. Reducían al culto todas las dimensiones de la religión. Jesús vino a mostrarles que la verdadera religión lleva a los líderes del Pueblo a un serio compromiso con la realidad, y a trabajar arduamente en la transformación de las estructuras para que garanticen el bien común, la justicia y la paz.

Los fariseos se esconden detrás de un legalismo narcisista. Los herodianos se aprovechan de su influencia política. Para ambos, la persona de Jesús de Nazaret es un problema, ya que sus palabras y sus gestos ponen en evidencia que sus corazones están lejos de Dios, lejos de la Ley y lejos del pueblo que deberían guiar, acompañar y cuidar. Jesús, al revelar al Padre y anunciar el Reino, deja ver la mediocridad y la incoherencia de los fariseos y de los herodianos.

En el Evangelio, los herodianos adulan a Jesús porque carecen de credibilidad. Jesús no se deja enredar por tales elogios vacíos y declara claramente su Verdad: "**hay que dar a Dios lo que es de Dios**". Jesús sabe que los fariseos buscan una excusa para poder acusarlo y no tiene miedo de dar una respuesta clara y comprometida **porque** habla desde su experiencia de Dios y desde su fe. Jesús no se ajusta al orden establecido, sobre todo cuando se acentúa la desigualdad, la injusticia o la inequidad.

A imagen de Jesucristo, los bautizados estamos llamados a crear lazos de fraternidad que rompan los esquemas de «ellos y nosotros». La corresponsabilidad de los cristianos en la búsqueda del bien común y en cuidado de la casa común nos llama a respetar la pluralidad.
