Parents can help their children with anxiety by practicing techniques for deep breathing, ensuring regular exercise and talking honestly about feelings and concerns. Dear Parishioners:

"Come ye, blessed of my Father; inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the creation of the world."

We will hear these words in the Gospel this Sunday that we celebrate the solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe. The Son of man will speak these words when, as king, he stands before all the peoples of the earth, at the end of the world. Then, to those at his right, he will say the words: inherit the kingdom ". This kingdom is the definitive gift of the Father. It is the gift matured "from the creation of the world ", in the course of all history of salvation. It is a gift of merciful love.

This Sunday's liturgy makes us aware that the essence of the kingdom is Life and not death. Death entered history because of sin. Grace belongs to the kingdom, not sin. Sin and death are enemies of the kingdom. Evil has penetrated the heart of man and of the history and they need the Reign of Christ to be overcome. His merciful love enters the world and penetrates the heart of man oppressed by sin and lust. Merciful love faces sin and death. Death was annihilated by the resurrection of Christ and that is his victory that elevates him as Lord and King.

However, in the world, death continues to dominate: because sin still weighs on the heart of man and on his history. Because Christ is not king of our hearts. Christ has to reign in order to overcome the slavery of sin and so that the world is no longer subjected to death. We must therefore submit everything to the One who has conquered everything, and whom God has placed above all. (1 Cor 15, 28).

How many in the world repeat every day the words "**thy kingdom come**", ultimately pray "may God be all in all." However, some, while praying "thy kingdom come", unfortunately, oppose his coming, even reject it. They refuse to say with the Psalmist "**The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing ...**" Let us ask Christ the King, as Good Shepherd, to prepare our hearts to do His will: to see Him in those who are hungry and to feed Him, to give Him water in those who are thirsty... to receive Him in the stranger and host Him, to discover Him in the imprisoned and in the sick to go visit Him.

Estimados Feligreses:

"Venid vosotros, benditos de mi Padre; heredad el reino preparado para vosotros desde la creación del mundo."

Escucharemos estas palabras en el Evangelio de este Domingo que celebramos la solemnidad de Cristo Rey del Universo. El Hijo del hombre pronunciará estas palabras cuando, como rey, se encuentre ante todos los pueblos de la tierra, al fin del mundo. Entonces, a todos los que se hallen a su derecha, les dirá las palabras: heredad el reino". Este reino es el don definitivo del Padre. Es el don madurado "desde la creación del mundo", en el curso de toda la historia de la salvación. Es don del amor misericordioso.

La liturgia de este domingo nos hace conscientes de que la esencia del reino es la Vida y no la muerte. La muerte entró en la historia por culpa del pecado. Al reino pertenece la gracia, no el pecado. El pecado y la muerte son enemigos del reino. El mal ha penetrado en el corazón del hombre y en su historia y necesitan el Reinado de Cristo para ser vencidos. Su amor misericordioso entra en el mundo y penetra en el corazón del hombre oprimido por el pecado y la concupiscencia. El amor misericordioso afronta el pecado y la muerte. La muerte fue aniquilada por la resurrección de Cristo y esa es su victoria que lo encumbra como Señor y Rey.

Sin embargo, en el mundo continúa dominando la muerte: porque sobre el corazón del hombre y sobre su historia pesa todavía el pecado. Porque Cristo no es rey de nuestros corazones. Cristo tiene que reinar para poder vencer la esclavitud del pecado y para que el mundo deje de estar sometido a la muerte. Hemos pues de someter todo a Aquel que lo ha vencido todo, y a Quien Dios puso por encima de todo. (1 Cor 15, 28).

Cuantos en el mundo repiten cada día las palabras "venga a nosotros tu reino", rezan en definitiva "para que Dios sea todo en todos". Sin embargo, algunos, mientras rezan "venga tu reino", por desgracia, se oponen a su venida, incluso la rechazan. Se niegan a decir con el Salmista "El Señor es mi pastor, nada me falta..." Pidamos a Cristo Rey, como Buen Pastor, que prepare nuestros corazones para hacer su voluntad: verlo en los que tienen hambre y darle de comer, darle de beber en lo que tienen sed... recibirlo en el forastero y hospedarlo; descubrirlo en el encarcelado y en el enfermo para ir a visitarlo.
