Did you know?

Many children will be learning in their own homes this fall, but that does not mean they will be fully protected from abuse. Sadly, most children are abused by someone considered to be a “known and trusted” person – that person may be a family member – even someone living in the same house as the child. Pay attention to the conversations your children are having, as words can be indicators that a child is being groomed or harmed. If your child or their friend(s) seem to “know” more about sexual topics than would be expected for their age, or seems unusually focused on such topics, it could be an indicator that something inappropriate and harmful is happening. Talk to your child about it, reassuring them that it is both important and safe to tell you what is happening. For more information on this topic, visit <https://lacatholics.org/did-you-know/>.

¿Sabía Que?

Muchos niños estarán aprendiendo desde sus propios hogares este otoño, pero eso no significa que estarán completamente protegidos de abuso. Lamentablemente, la mayoría de los niños son abusados por alguien que se considera una persona “conocida y de confianza”, que pudiera ser un miembro de la familia, y que hasta puede vivir en la misma casa que el niño o niña. Preste atención a las conversaciones de sus hijos, ya que las palabras pueden ser indicadores de que un niño está siendo abusado o dañado sexualmente. Si su hijo/a o sus amigos parecen “saber” más sobre temas sexuales de lo que se espera para su edad, o parecen inusualmente enfocados en esos temas, esto puede ser indicador de que algo inapropiado o dañino está sucediendo. Hable con sus hijos sobre estos temas, asegurándoles que es importante y seguro que ellos le digan lo que está sucediendo. Dear Parishioner's,

In today's Gospel, Jesus continues to respond to the accusations of those who feel like defenders and masters of God's law. A more violent debate is on the rise on the part of the Pharisees, but clearer and more direct on the part of Jesus. His adversaries are unwilling to change the law. Jesus, who has come to fulfill the law, rebukes them harshly, treating them as hypocrites. Because the Pharisees say to fulfill it, they say - "I'm going Lord" but they don't go. On the other hand, those who, having said, even in a rude and shameless way, that they do not want to know anything about God or his justice, have fulfilled the law by loving and caring for their neighbor and, for this reason, are praised by Jesus who says that they carry the lead in the Kingdom of God; publicans and prostitutes believe in Jesus, have repented and have been converted. Meanwhile the scribes and Pharisees feel justified. They are like the hare in Aesop's fable.

The Lord, once again, gently and tenderly strikes our conscience to make our relationship with God the Father more intimate and accept His law in our hearts. He knows our weakness, He knows what clay we are made of.

The prophet Ezekiel shows us the stubbornness of our behavior and our complaint against the Lord for considering that the Lord's behavior is not fair. He invites us to look carefully at our intentions and the falsehoods that we can hide to reconsider in time and live. Let us pay attention to Saint Paul and remain unanimous and agree with the same love and the same feeling with others. The Christian way is communal. We cannot seek our own sanctification without worrying about that of others. Having the same feelings as Christ, who had compassion, both when giving food and forgiving sins.

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús sigue respondiendo a las críticas y acusaciones de los que se sienten defensores y amos de la ley de Dios. Va en aumento un debate más violento por una parte de los fariseos, pero más claro y directo por parte de Jesús. Sus adversarios no están dispuestos a cambiar la ley. Jesús, que ha venido para dar plenitud a la ley les reprende con dureza tratándoles de hipócritas. Porque los fariseos dicen cumplirla, dicen -"voy Señor" pero no van-. En cambio, los que, habiendo dicho, incluso de forma grosera y descarada, que no quieren saber nada de Dios ni de su justicia, la han cumplido al amar y cuidar del prójimo y -por ello- son alabados por Jesús quien dice que llevan la delantera en el Reino de Dios; los publicanos y las prostitutas creen en Jesús, se han arrepentido y se han convertido. Mientras tanto los escribas y fariseos se sienten justificados. Son como la liebre en la fábula de Esopo.

El Señor, una vez más, golpea sutil y tiernamente nuestra conciencia para que nuestra relación con Dios Padre sea íntima, es decir, que acojamos su voluntad de corazón. Él conoce nuestra debilidad, sabe de qué masa estamos hechos. No pretendamos engañarle.

El profeta Ezequiel, nos muestra la tozudez de nuestro comportamiento y nuestra queja contra el Señor por considerar que no es justo el proceder del Señor. Nos invita a mirar con detenimiento nuestras intenciones y las falsedades que podamos esconder para recapacitar a tiempo y vivir. Que hagamos caso a San Pablo y nos mantengamos unánimes y concordes con un mismo amor y un mismo sentir con los demás. El camino cristiano es comunitario. No podemos buscar la propia santificación sin preocuparnos de la de los demás. Teniendo los mismos sentimientos de Cristo, que se compadecía, tanto a la hora de dar alimento, como de perdonar los pecados.
